




# Richard Hanson's Give My Regards to Broadway Spring Theatre Tour

In the constellation of musical comedy masterpieces, *Kiss Me, Kate* shines as Broadway's most sparkling achievement. Based on Shakespeare's *The Taming of the Shrew*, *Kiss Me Kate* showcases the genius of Cole Porter at his stylish, sexy, sophisticated best with *Too Darn Hot*, *So In Love*, *Always True To You In My Fashion*, and *Brush Up Your Shakespeare*. Tony Award winner Kelli O'Hara and Tony nominee Will Chase will catapult you to musical comedy heaven, with a spectacular new revival of *Kiss Me Kate*.



Harper Lee's Pulitzer prize -winning American classic *To Kill a Mockingbird* comes to Broadway in a new adaptation by Aaron Sorkin directed by Bartlett Sher and starring Jeff Daniels as Atticus Finch. In 1943 *Oklahoma!* opened on Broadway and revolutionized the American Musical Theatre. 76 years later, a stunning new revival reimagines *Oklahoma!* for the 21st century. Set in Indian Territory in the early 20th century, just before Oklahoma became a state, the influential Rodgers and Hammerstein musical depicts a love triangle unfolding against the backdrop of a transforming nation. Directed by Daniel Fish, this innovative production moves to Broadway this spring after a critically-acclaimed and sold-out Off Broadway run.

Stay **6 nights at the historic Warwick Hotel**, built in 1926 by William Randolph Hearst for the love of his life, actress Marion Davies. The hotel is steps away from Rockefeller Plaza, Central Park, The Museum of Modern Art, Broadway theatres and Fifth Avenue shopping.

- Take a horse-drawn carriage ride through **Central Park**.
- Visit the **New York Historical Society Museum** and tour its spectacular collection of Tiffany lamps. Learn the hidden history and discover the contributions of women in the creation of this art.
- Enjoy lunch at the iconic **Tavern on the Green**, a Central Park jewel since 1934.
- Take the ferry to **Ellis Island** and visit the **National Museum of Immigration**.
- Linger over lunch at **Delmonico's**, America's first restaurant, in business since 1837.
- Spend the afternoon exploring the **Metropolitan Museum of Art**.
- Enjoy discussions of our theatre experiences led by Professor Hanson during morning meetings.
- Gather for a pre-theatre dinner at **Sardi's**, or another well-known theatre district favorite.
- Celebrate the highlights of the week with a farewell dinner at **Remi's** where chef Mirco Delvecchio serves up the delicious cuisine of Venice.
